- chili (with meat and vegetarian)

- canned soups (preferably ready-to-serve)
- baking mixes (e.g., Bisquick, cake and brownie mixes, quick breads, etc.)
- baking supplies (e.g., flour, sugar, chocolate chips, etc.)
- tea and coffee
- condiments (e.g., ketchup, mustard, salad dressing)
- other non-perishables heat and serve meals
- paper products (e.g., toilet paper, tissues, paper towels)
- soap, shampoo, tooth paste, dental floss

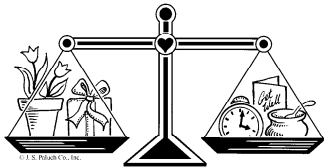

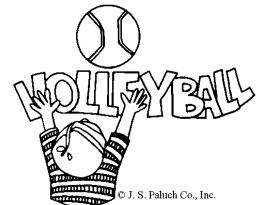
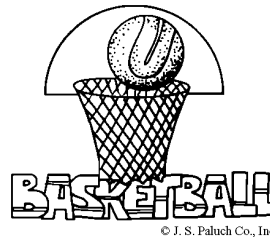
