St. Rita protocols for parishioners upon entering the Church

- -Enter only through the two side doors.
- -Everyone must wear a face mask at all times.
- -Upon entering, give your signed Archdiocesan waiver to the usher; then sign the Guest Book, each time.
- -Sit anywhere designated by an orange masking tape marker.
- -Any time before or after Mass, place your donation in the wooden collection box located in the center aisle.
- -Singing or speaking loudly is prohibited at all times.
- -The Mass may or may not be accompanied by live instrumental music.
- -Following the Our Father prayer, the "exchange of peace" may be fulfilled with a simple nod.
- -At Communion, form a single file line, following the yellow markers to the front. The priest will place the consecrated host directly into you open hand. To consume, lift open your mask and then replace.
- -The bathroom will be available upon requests made to an usher.
- -The coffee/tea/juice/donuts/pastries post-9:00AM Mass social has been temporarily suspended until COVID-19 passes.
- -The priest will enter and exit the sanctuary through the sacristy.
